I am writing to inform you that the Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps Unit of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill is forming an Alumni Association. The UNC General Alumni Association is cooperating and providing guidance in this effort. The primary goals of the organization will be to:

1. Form an organization which will contact and inform all previous graduates of NROTC activities and events.
2. Sponsor social gatherings which will be open to all members and likely coincide with Homecoming, UNC athletic events and other NROTC activities throughout the year.
3. Assist unit recruiting efforts by providing referrals to the unit recruiting officer and information to prospective midshipmen.
4. Publish a periodic newsletter which will contain information regarding association activities, upcoming events and short articles or stories submitted by the members.

The organization's Board of Directors will be made up of UNC NROTC graduates who have expressed a desire to serve in that capacity. Please let us know if you are interested in board membership. The Board will initially meet to establish operating guidelines and by-laws which will then be published and made available to all members. Election of officers will take place at the first general membership meeting to be held during Homecoming 1990.

Since 1940 the unit has produced 1500 commissioned officers who have served in both the U.S. Navy and Marine Corps. We want to help put you back in touch with your former classmates and we want you to help us spread the word about our association's formation so that we can reach as many people as possible in the shortest time. Suggestions or comments would be most appreciated and we would especially like to hear from you if you have an address correction or if you know a classmate's address. We intend to have the first newsletter and schedule of events published sometime in the spring. Until then, **GO HEELS!!**
